Upon completion of this lesson, students will understand the importance of good character traits and self-discipline in the workplace.

Discipline: Training to act according to the rules.

Self-Discipline: The ability to control your feelings and overcome your weaknesses; the

ability to pursue what you think is right despite temptations.

Character: the way you think, feel and behave; your personality.
